The goal of this workshop is to bring together European macroeconomists to discuss current research frontiers on a regular basis. To encourage participation from young economists, we aim to reserve 50% of the presentation for economists who have completed their PhD's no more than 6 years ago.

Applications from economists from *all* European institutions are welcomed in all fields of macroeconomics. Theoretical and empirical contributions are equally welcome.

The workshop is a one day event which will take place at Banque de France (Paris) on **5 June 2014**. The key-note speaker will be **Thomas Philippon** (New York Stern). A conference dinner is scheduled in the evening of 4 June 2014. Travel and accommodation expenses will be covered.
