The conference begins with a PhD workshop for doctoral students on the 5<sup>th</sup> of June, 2023. Doctoral students are invited to submit their papers for this special workshop. The main conference will take place on the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> of June, 2023.

**Location:**
