The scientific advisory board will select eight papers for presentation by doctoral students on March 8, and the Ph.D. Symposium will be followed by a general workshop consisting of invited papers on March 9. For the eight selected Ph.D. students, registration to the Ph.D. Symposium and the workshop is free of charge and accommodation will be provided. The Symposium will also honor the best student presentation with the Credit Mutuel Nord Europe award (1.000 €).
